COSTUME INFORMATION

Theatre Unlimited Performing Arts costumes its own productions. You may or may not have worked with us, and to that end, there is some information we would like to share with you about this process.

TUPA has a large inventory of costumes which is utilized for each show. In addition, costume pieces are created by a team of volunteers each year to fulfill the costume requirements.

As a member of TUPA, your costumes are provided as part of your fee. However, there will be items you are asked to provide. We strive to keep such requests as simple as possible without jeopardizing the overall quality and look of our costume design.

All actors are generally required to provide their own foot wear.

For women, this most often means black character shoes. However, sometimes beige is also necessary. Depending on the show, other foot wear may be required, such as a pair of boots and dance or jazz shoes.

Men are typically expected to have a good pair of black lace up dress shoes. Additional requests may be dance shoes or some type of boot.

Women are expected to provide their own undergarments and pantyhose / dance tights / socks. Sometimes, an item like a skirt or blouse that you have might be requested or you may be asked to help seek out an occasional piece of clothing.

Men are expected to provide their own undergarments (such as undershirts) and socks. As well, men may be asked to provide an item like a dress shirt or a pair of pants. Men may also be requested to help seek out an occasional piece of clothing.
